

Elite Meet Safety Plan

General

- The current GCIT emergency plan is more than adequate for all types of emergencies.
- Middle Atlantic's responsibility will be to ensure that all key meet workers will be briefed on how to activate the emergency plan.

Responsibilities

- Facilities personnel (Schwerzler/Sprang)
 - Ensure red phone is working
 - Have back-up phone services available (office phone can direct dial 911)
 - Manager on duty to identify himself to MA meet personnel
 - Manage the emergency
- MA personnel (Ramone/Joyce)
 - Brief program sales people, who will be the first point of contact for any emergency occurring in stands or in hallway.
 - Brief safety marshals, site directors, announcer

Plan Activation

In the event of any kind of emergency, the person who first becomes aware of it will notify one of the following people: Aquatics management personnel (Jack Schwerzler or Matt Sprang), a lifeguard, or MA Safety personnel (Mike Ramone or Ruthann Joyce). If Mike or Ruthann is the first point of contact, they will in turn notify GCIT management or lifeguard staff. GCIT staff will then take over.

In the event of any kind of emergency, the GCIT emergency plan will be activated. To initiate action, please take the following steps:

- **If you are on deck or in a locker room**, notify one of the following people:
 - Aquatics Management staff – Jack Schwerzler or Matt Sprang
 - Safety personnel on site – Mike Ramone or Ruthann Joyce
 - Any Lifeguard

- **If you are in the stands or in the hallway**, notify the personnel at the programs sales table.

These individuals know how to activate the emergency plan.
