FACILITIES	<p>The PHS pool is a new indoor Paddock, 25 yard, 8 lane pool with non-turbulent lane markers, Colorado Timing system with 8 line scoreboard display. Water depth at the starting end is 12 feet. An adjacent warm-up and warm-down pool is available for swimmers. Free parking, large seating capacity, concession stand and swim equipment vendor are available.</p>

ELIGIBILITY	<p>This meet is open to all swimmers registered with USA Swimming. Swimmer's age as of November 5, 2004 will apply for the entire meet.</p>
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	<p>The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries, events or heats, or to modify the meet format to conform with Middle Atlantic rules. Swimmers/teams eliminated from the meet due to time or space constraints will be given a full refund. Prompt notification will be made to swimmers or teams if changes impact their entries. A swimmer may swim in five individual events and 1 relay per day.</p>
ORDER OF EVENTS	<p>See attached sheet listing the order of events, event numbers, the starting times for each session and the warm-up schedule.</p>
WARM-UP & START TIMES	<p>Team lane assignments and warm-up schedule will be distributed on-site in the coach's package. Circle swimming only during warm-up until sprint lanes are opened. No diving is permitted during warm-up, except supervised diving in designated sprint lanes. When diving is permitted, swimmer must enter from the starting blocks and exit from the opposite end of the pool.</p>
DECK ENTRIES	<p>Subject to space availability, and at the discretion of the Meet Director, deck entries will be accepted on the day of the meet, prior to the start of each session, at the cost of \$6.00 per event. Deck-entered swimmers will compete unofficially; the achieved time is official, but will not score in the meet for points or awards. To enter, please see the MD before or during warm-ups.</p>
SWIMMERS WITHOUT A COACH	<p>Swimmers unaccompanied by a credentialed coach should report to the Meet Director before the warm-up for each session.</p>
SEEDING	<p>All Friday night events are Positive Check-in. All other events will be pre-seeded based on entry time.</p>

HOW TO ENTER	<p>Electronic entries in a Hy-Tek Commlink file are preferred.</p> <p><u>Entries may be sent via e-mail.</u> Include with your Commlink file a Team Manager report by entry (saved in Word for Windows format). In the body of your e-mail, provide the number of girls, boys and entries. Include contact information (name, address, phone and cell phone). Send to smlewis@rcn.com/ Send entry check separately. It must arrive by Friday Oct. 22, 2004.</p> <p><u>Entries may be sent on a 3.5" diskette.</u> Include a Team Manager report by entry (saved in Word for Windows format); the PAAC Meet Summary Form and your payment.</p> <p>Entries may be sent in using the PAAC Meet Entry Form(s). The PAAC Meet Summary Form and your payment. There is a \$2.00 per swimmer surcharge for manually entered entries. Times must be submitted in the course in which they were achieved.</p>
ENTRY FEES	<p>Entry fee is \$3.00 per individual event and \$6.00 for a relay. \$2.00 per swimmer surcharge for manually entered entries.</p>

ENTRY DEADLINE	<p>Entries must be received no later than October 22, 2004 at 6:00 PM. No late entries will be accepted.</p>
RULES	<p>This meet will be conducted according to current USA Swimming rules. Middle Atlantic Swimming rules shall also apply. USA SWIMMING / MA SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ENTIRE MEET.</p> <p>Only currently credentialed coaches, USA Swimming registered athletes and essential meet personnel will be permitted on deck. This meet will be conducted using the Whistle command and No-Recall False Start procedures.</p> <p>Any swimmer observed swimming under or through the Bulkhead by an Official or Safety Monitor at the Meet will be disqualified from that swimmer's next Individual Event or from the remainder of the Meet, as determined by the Meet Referee. This policy will be strictly enforced</p> <p>Entries submitted must be swimmer's best verifiable USA Swimming sanctioned time. Entry of time other than swimmer's best for any event may result in the swimmer's suspension from competition for a minimum of 3 months, but not more than 1 year.</p> <p>Any swimmer who is positively checked in for an event, and then does not swim that event, will be scratched from their next individual event.</p>
SCORING & AWARDS	<p>This meet will be scored at each level: A, B and C for each event. The top eight times in each level will receive awards. 'A' individual entries: medals 1st to 3rd, ribbons 4th to 8th. 'B' individual entries: rosettes 1st to 3rd, ribbons 4th to 8th. 'C' individual entries: ribbons 1st to 8th. Relays entries: medals to 1st, ribbons to 2nd to 3rd. Award levels determined by entry time.</p>
PROGRAMS & ADMISSION	<p>Program is \$10.00 for the entire meet. No admission fee is charged. A free heat sheet will be given to non-PAAC volunteers, if the meet director requests help in running the meet.</p>
RESULTS	<p>Results will be posted on the Middle Atlantic website at www.maswim.org.</p>
DIRECTIONS	<p>From the PA turnpike, Exit 33, take Route 22 east, then exit onto Cedar Crest Blvd north. Travel north on Cedar Crest Blvd for approximately 1.9 miles. Parkland High School is on the left. The pool is on the left hand side of the complex. Park in the parking lot in front of the school, closest to the Athletics door. Walk through the Athletics entrance to admissions. Follow the signs inside the school.</p>
