FACILITY 6 lane, 25 yard, MA certified competition pool in the Medill Bair Sports Complex located on the grounds of Pennsbury High School East, 705 Hood Boulevard, Fairless Hills, PA 19030. There is a large spectator's gallery and ample parking. Colorado Timing System and Scoreboard with 6 lane display. Pool is equipped with lane lines and starting blocks. Depth is 10' from the starting blocks, 3.5' for turns at the shallow end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

ELIGIBILITY This meet is open to all swimmers age 12 & under registered with USA Swimming and will be conducted according to current USA-S rules. Swimmer's age is as of the first day of the meet. On-site registrations will not be accepted at this meet. Each swimmer must be registered through his/her LSC prior to competition.

ENTRIES Swimmers may enter a maximum of **five (5)** individual events. Entries must be made using Hytek Team Manager software and submitted by email, with an accompanying meet summary report sorted by swimmer. Swimmers must enter best time in each event. Entries with no times will be seeded NT. All events will be swum as timed finals.

DEADLINE Entries are due by **Saturday April 23, 2011. No Post Entries Will Be Accepted.**

FORMAT Current USA and Middle Atlantic LSC rules will govern the meet. The whistle start and no recall false start rules will be in use. USA Swimming/Middle Atlantic Swimming Safety Guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect for the entire meet. Only currently credentialed coaches, USA Swimming registered athletes and meet personnel will be permitted on deck.

Racing Start Certification: Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ENTRY FEES Individual Events = \$4.00.... Deck Entries will be accepted based on available space – an \$8.00 per swimmer fee applies. Swimmers not previously entered in the meet must provide proof of current USA Swimming registration. No on-site registration will be accepted. Deck Entries should see Kathy Jeronis Meet Director.

AWARDS Rosettes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event, ribbons will be awarded for places 4 through 8. Results will be emailed to each team's coach and Middle Atlantic Swimming and posted on the Middle Atlantic website: www.maswim.org.

RULES USA Swimming rules will be in effect. The Meet Director reserves the right to make changes to the meet, if needed, in order to minimize the impact of weather conditions and ensure that competition is completed within the parameters of the meet. Deck access is limited to coaches, officials, swimmers and meet personnel.

Meet Director reserves the right to limit the number of heats in order to meet the four hour session rule. Refunds will be mailed to all teams for those swimmers whose events that are eliminated

Current USA and Middle Atlantic LSC rules will govern the meet. **'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.** USA swimming/ MA swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect for the entire meet. Only currently credentialed coaches, USA swimming registered athletes and meet personnel will be permitted on deck.

SAFETY USA Swimming and Middle Atlantic safety procedures will be enforced. Feet first entries are required during warm-ups. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

OFFICIALS USA officials from the invited teams are encouraged to volunteer – please contact Andy Raffle (Andy@AskAndyRaffle.com or 215.917.3937) if you are available. Teams will be asked to also supply timers proportionate to their number of swimmers.

ADMISSION/FOOD \$3 admission, \$2 programs. Full concession/snack bar will be available. Hospitality suite for coaches/officials. No food is permitted on pool deck.

Directions:**FROM PA TURNPIKE:**

Turnpike East to Exit 351. Merge onto US 1 North. 7.7 Miles to Oxford Valley Road exit (this is the Sesame Place exit). Right at top of ramp to Oxford Valley Road. 1 Mile to left turn on North Oxford Valley Road (at Wawa at light AFTER Pep Boys). 1 Mile to left on Hood Boulevard (Pizza Hut on Corner). 1 Mile to school on left. Natatorium is free standing building to the left of the school in front of football stadium.

FROM I-95 SOUTH:

Cross Scudder Falls Bridge into Pennsylvania and travel South for 6 miles to US 1 North. After 1 mile exit at Oxford Valley Road and follow directions above.

FROM I-95 NORTH:

Take Exit 40 for PA-413 North/Veterans Highway. Travel 1.4 Miles to RIGHT on New Falls Road. 3.7 Miles to LEFT on Hood Boulevard. School is just ahead on Right. Enter second driveway. Natatorium is free standing building to the left of the school in front of football stadium.
