

Middle Atlantic Meet Volunteer Job Descriptions

Computer and Colorado Operators

Training is required

Clubs that have trained Computer and Colorado operators are asked to encourage their workers to help out at Championship meets.

Scorer

Works directly with Computer Operator

Augments Computer operator by organizing paperwork and helping to obtain backup times from timers

Report to Meet Director 20 minutes before the start of the meet and remain for the duration of the session.

Runner

Works closely with the computer operators for posting of results

Worker must be on deck 20 minutes before the start of the meet and is expected to remain throughout the duration of the session

Admissions

Sells programs to spectators; collects and returns program/admission money to Meet Director

Report to Meet Director at the start of warm ups and remain until after the start of the meet.

Announcer

Works closely with Officials and Meet Director

Announces results of completed events.

Report at start of warm up and remain throughout the entire session

Timers

Officials will refresh timers on timing procedure before each session

Report to Scorer's table 30 minutes before meets starts.

This position requires worker to be on deck throughout entire session.

Volunteer Coordinator

Report to Meet Director at the start of warm ups

Check in team workers to the assigned positions

Duties are complete at the start of each session

Safety

Along with Meet and Safety Director monitor pool deck for any safety concerns.
