

INFORMATION FOR THE SUMMER 2007 ZONE TEAM

EQUIPMENT –

- All equipment should be picked up at Junior Olympics at the Zone Team table.
- Swimmers can only purchase the zone equipment if they are attending the 2007 Summer Zone Meet.
- The equipment package is mandatory for all team members.
- If you cannot pick up your equipment at JO's you must make arrangements with Michele Paules (markpaules@yahoo.com), MA Zone Team Manager, to have someone pick up your equipment at the meet. You will have to provide that person's name and they will have to sign for your equipment to be turned over to them. Because of space reasons we cannot transport any equipment to Buffalo.
- There will be equipment from past Zone Meets for current and former MA Zone Team members to purchase. This equipment will be sold at great prices at the Zone Team table at JO's.
- Current and former Zone Team members will be able to sign up and pay for MA Zone Team parkas at JO's. The cost will be \$135 and will cover shipping to your home.

MEET REGISTRATION –

- All applications for events achieved as of July 15, 2007 must be in the Middle Atlantic office by Friday, July 20, 2007.
- If you qualify for events after July 15th you will be able to register for these events at Junior Olympics at the Zone Team table. A form will be available to sign up for new events and update times for events already entered.
- For entries and equipment we will only accept cash, checks or money orders. **NO CREDIT CARDS WHATSOEVER WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY PAYMENTS.**

OPEN WATER ZONES –

- The Open Water Zone race will be held on August 12th. Please go here to see the meet announcement and registration procedure: http://www.pvswim.org/eastzone/07ezlc_ow.pdf. Please remember that a coach's signature is required, this must be from your home coach.
- The Open Water Zone race is open to anyone who would like to swim the race, is able to complete the distance and meets the eligibility requirements.
- **YOU DO NOT HAVE TO QUALIFY FOR "POOL" EVENTS TO SWIM THE OPEN WATER RACE. ANY MIDDLE ATLANTIC SWIMMER**

WHO MEETS THE ELIDGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND HAS A COACH VERIFY THEY CAN MAKE THE DISTANCE CAN SWIM IN THE OPEN WATER ZONE RACE.

- You must register and pay for the open water race on your own. Middle Atlantic will not be processing entries for this race.
